GED class enrollment process consists of an **ORIENTATION** and computerized **DIAGNOSTIC TESTING**, each session will take 2 – 3 hours.

1. Pre-register in person at the receptionist desk or by calling (239) 377-0900.
 - **MONDAY – ORIENTATION** 8:15 a.m. or 5:15 p.m. Bring the following:
 1. Florida drivers license or State of Florida Photo I.D.
 2. Social Security Card
 Walk-ins accepted if space is available.
 - **WEDNESDAY – DIAGNOSTIC TESTING** 8:15 a.m. or 5:15 p.m.
If the Monday/Wednesday orientation and testing does not meet your schedule, please contact (239) 377-0981 to make other arrangements.
2. If you are under 18 years old, you and your parent must attend a **Parent/Teacher Conference before Orientation**. You will need to bring your Florida Drivers License or State of Florida ID card (high school photos are not accepted.)
 - Day Conferences - Tuesday or Thursday at 2:00 p.m. or Wednesday at 7:30 a.m.
 - Evening Conferences - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday at 7:30 p.m.

What is the GED testing program?

The GED (General Educational Development) test is a battery of five tests designed to measure the major concepts generally associated with four years of high school education. Successful completion of the GED test will earn you a **STATE OF FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA**, which could open doors to jobs, promotions, college, and many other opportunities. The subject areas and time limits covered are:

- MATHEMATICS (1HR 30 MIN)
- LANGUAGE ARTS/WRITING/ESSAY (2 HRS)
- SCIENCE (1 HR 20 MIN)
- SOCIAL STUDIES (1 HR 10 MIN)

**HOW TO APPLY FOR THE GED TEST/AND
COST**

Persons who plan to take the GED Tests must register and pay the required testing fee prior to the testing date. \$45.00 for the complete test, \$9.00 for each individual test. Testing fees may be paid by cash or check. Please make your check or money order payable to **Collier County Public Schools**. You must show a Florida Drivers License or State of Florida Identification card and a Social Security card.
